PURSUANT to the Industries and Commerce Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Board of Trade (Wheat and Flour) Regulations 1944, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Board of Trade (Wheat and Flour) Regulations 1944\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 231 of the principal regulations (as added by regulation 2 of the Board of Trade (Wheat and Flour) Regulations 1944, Amendment No. 8) is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) By adding to paragraph (b) of subclause (1) the words "or in 1962":
- (b) By inserting in subclause (3), after the words "in 1961", the words "or in 1962".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations provide for the payment of an additional levy of  $\frac{1}{2}$ d. a bushel for the payment of storage charges for wheat harvested in 1962. The levy already applies in respect of wheat harvested in 1961.
