HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the provisions of section 26 of the Board of Trade Act, 1919, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, and deeming the provisions hereinafter contained to be necessary in the public interest for divers of the purposes set out in the said section, doth hereby make the following regulations for the purposes of the said Act.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Board of Trade (Meat Grading) Regulations 1943, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Board of Trade (Meat Grading) Regulations 1943* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2) of Regulation 1 the words " twenty-eight days after notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof ", and substituting the words " on the 15th day of November, 1943 ".
