

THE BOARD OF TRADE (BREAD-PRICE) REGULATIONS 1936, AMENDMENT NO. 1

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

In pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon him by the Board of Trade Act, 1919, and of every other power and authority enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Board of Trade (Breadprice) Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall come into force on the 9th day of August, 1943.

3. The Schedule to the Board of Trade (Bread-price) Regulations 1936* is hereby amended by inserting, next after the word "Petone", the words "and the Town District of Johnsonville", and further by inserting, next after the words "Auckland Central Post Office", the words "exclusive of Waiheke Island".
