## THE BYLAWS REGULATIONS 1968

ARTHUR PORRITT, Governor-General

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 8th day of April 1968

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Bylaws Act 1910, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Bylaws Regulations 1968.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1968.

**2. Application for confirmation of bylaws**—(1) Every application by a local authority for the confirmation of a bylaw in accordance with section 3 of the Act shall be made in form 1 in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Every such application shall be accompanied by a statutory declaration in or to the effect of form 2 in the Schedule to these regulations.

**3. Fee**—A fee of \$10 shall be paid in respect of each such application.

**4. Revocation**—The regulations respecting the confirmation of bylaws made on the 15th day of February 1911\* are hereby revoked.

## SCHEDULE

## Form 1

## APPLICATION FOR CONFIRMATION OF BYLAWS

*Under Section 3 of the Bylaws Act 1910*

To the Minister of Internal Affairs, Wellington.

## STATUTORY DECLARATION

*Under Section 3 of the Bylaws Act 1910*

5. That all conditions of the validity and operation of the said bylaw (or bylaws) up to the date of this declaration have been duly fulfilled or performed.

6. That the said bylaw (or bylaws) has (or have) been duly published in accordance with the requirements of section \_\_\_\_\_ of the [*name of Act requiring publication*].\*

These regulations revise the former regulations relating to the confirmation of bylaws, and increase the fee from \$6.30 to \$10.
