REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Beer Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Beer Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1986.

2. Altering Title of principal regulations—The principal regulations may hereafter be cited as the Beer Regulations 1978.

3. Annual licence fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 6.

4. Delivery of samples to brewer—Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “without payment of duty”.

5. Schedule—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1986,—

- (a) Remove the reference to annual licence fees, which are to be dealt with under the Customs Act 1966:
 - (b) Remove the reference to beer duty, which is replaced by excise duty.
