**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 22nd day of November 1982

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 57A of the Building Societies Act 1965, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Building Societies (Home Ownership and Farm Ownership Accounts) Order 1981, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Building Societies (Home Ownership and Farm Ownership Accounts) Order 1981\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Schedule extended**—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the words “Canterbury Building Society” and the words “Northern United Building Society”, and by inserting in their appropriate alphabetical order the words “Countrywide Building Society” and “United Building Society”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order authorises the Countrywide Building Society to accept deposits from its members in home ownership and farm ownership accounts. The 2 societies omitted from the Schedule have combined to form the United Building Society.
