## THE CUSTOMS AGREEMENT APPLICATION ORDER 1937.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Acts pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Customs

Amendment Act, 1921, the Trade Agreement (New Zealand and
Germany) Ratification Act, 1937, and all other powers and
authorities enabling in that behalf.

Date on which the regulations were made: 11th day of October, 1937. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 11th day of October, 1937.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Agreement Application Order 1937.
- 2. The duties provided for by the Trade Agreement (New Zealand and Germany) Ratification Act, 1937, in respect of goods being the produce or manufacture of Germany are hereby applied to similar goods being the produce or manufacture of the countries set out in the Schedule hereto.
- 3. Every application of duties hereby effected shall be subject to the provisions of section 143 of the Customs Act, 1913, and all duties of Customs that have become due and payable and all penalties and forfeitures that have been incurred prior to the coming into force of this Order shall be recovered and enforced as if this Order had not been made.
- 4. This Order shall come into force on the 12th day of October, 1937.
