### Regulations

- 1 Title**  
These regulations are the Civil Aviation Charges Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2007.

**2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on 13 December 2007.

**3 Principal regulations amended**

These regulations amend the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations (No 2) 1991.

**4 International passenger security charges**

Regulation 20(1) is amended by omitting “\$12.56” and substituting “\$15.00”.

**5 Domestic passenger security charges**

Regulation 20A(1) is amended by omitting “\$3.57” and substituting “\$4.66”.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 13 December 2007, amend the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations (No 2) 1991.

The amendments increase—

- the international passenger security charge from \$12.56 to \$15.00; and
  - the domestic passenger security charge from \$3.57 to \$4.66.
