

THE CIVIL AVIATION CHARGES REGULATIONS 1954, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to the Civil Aviation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations 1954* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. The Schedule of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "Timaru", the word "Wanganui".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

The purpose of these regulations is to add Wanganui Aerodrome to the schedule of aerodromes in respect of which the principal regulations authorize the payment of airways dues and airport dues.
