**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 7th day of May 1973

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Civil Aviation Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. **Title**—These regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations 1965\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. **Airways dues payable by domestic operators**—Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the first proviso to subclause (1) (as substituted by regulation 3 (1) of the Civil Aviation Charges Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 7) the expression "1973", and substituting the expression "1974".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

During the period 1 January 1972 to 31 March 1973, airways dues payable by domestic operators were reduced from 8 percent to 6 percent of gross operating revenue.

These regulations extend the period during which the reduced rate is payable to 31 March 1974.
