Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Customs and Excise Amendment Regulations 2007.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 September 2007.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Customs and Excise Regulations 1996.

4 Minimum amount of duty collectable

Regulation 70(3) is amended by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (aa):

"(ab) any alcoholic beverages, that is any goods specified in headings 22.03, 22.04, 22.05, 22.06, 22.08, 99.10, 99.20, 99.25, 99.30, 99.45, and 99.50 of Schedule 3 of the Act; or".

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 September 2007, amend the Customs and Excise Regulations 1996 (the **principal regulations**). The amendment removes alcoholic beverages from the scope of regulation 70 of the principal regulations, which provides that in specified circumstances duty below \$50 need not be collected. The amendment is related to the new concession for alcoholic beverages brought into New Zealand by passengers.
