PURSUANT to section 62 of the Corporations (Investigation and Management) Act 1989, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Corporations (Investigation and Management) Order 1991.

2. Termination of statutory management of corporation—It is hereby declared that Orion Developments Limited shall cease to be subject to statutory management on the 10th day of June 1991.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order declares that Orion Developments Limited, a company in the Equiticorp group of companies, shall cease to be subject to statutory management on 10 June 1991.

The effect of the order is that, in accordance with section 62 (3) of the Corporations (Investigation and Management) Act 1989,—

- (a) The company ceases to be subject to statutory management on that date; and
- (b) The appointment of the statutory managers terminates in respect of the company on that date; and
- (c) The appointment of any person as a member of an advisory committee in relation to the statutory management of that company terminates on that date.
