PURSUANT to section 62 of the Corporations (Investigation and Management) Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Corporations (Investigation and Management) Order (No. 4) 1990.

**2. Termination of statutory management of Northern Pulp Limited and Triboard Marketing Limited**—It is hereby declared that Northern Pulp Limited and Triboard Marketing Limited shall cease to be subject to statutory management on the 18th day of September 1990.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order declares that Northern Pulp Limited and Triboard Marketing Limited (both of which are members of the Equiticorp group of companies) shall cease to be subject to statutory management under the Corporations (Investigation and Management) Act 1989 on 18 September 1990.

The effect of the order is that in accordance with section 62 (3) of that Act—

- (a) Each of those companies ceases to be subject to statutory management on 18 September 1990:
- (b) The appointment of the statutory managers terminates in respect of those companies on that date.
