THE CUSTOMS AMENDING REGULATIONS 1946

At the Government House at Wellington, this 28th day of August, 1946

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 309 of the Customs Act, 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs Amending Regulations 1946, and shall be deemed to be part of the Customs Regulations published in the *Gazette* on the 2nd day of July, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations*).

2. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of

September, 1946.

3. Regulation 10 of the principal regulations, as amended by the Customs (Tariff Preference and General) Regulations 1936†, is revoked, and the following substituted:—

"10. The working-hours of the Customs for the purposes of

Section 17 of the said Act shall be as follows:—

"(a) Officers for whose workinghours no other provision is hereby made

On Mondays to Fridays inclusive, either from 8 a.m. to 4.35 p.m. or 8.30 a.m. to 5.5 p.m., as may be directed by the Comptroller.

"(b) Boarding Inspectors and Searchers

Forty hours a week, to be arranged according to the requirements of shipping between the hours of 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and 8 a.m. to noon on Saturdays.

"(c) Preventive Officers

. Forty hours a week, to be arranged according to the requirements of shipping on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive."

4. Regulation 133 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following substituted:

"133. All duties, fees, or charges payable under the Customs Acts shall be paid at the Customhouse on Mondays to Fridays inclusive between the hours either of 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. or 8.30 a.m. to 3 p.m., as may be directed by the Comptroller:

"Provided that with the permission of the Collector such payments may be made after the hour of 3 p.m."
