THE CUSTOMS AMENDING REGULATIONS 1947

At the Government House at Wellington, this 29th day of October, 1947

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 309 of the Customs Act, 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs Amending Regulations 1947.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Customs Regulations made on the 29th day of June, 1914, and published in the *Gazette* on the 2nd day of July, 1914, at page 2675, hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations.
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the Gazette of the making thereof.
- 4. Form 40 in the Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby revoked, and the form 40 in the Schedule hereto is substituted.
- 5. Notwithstanding that form 40 revoked by the last preceding regulation differs from form 40 prescribed thereby, the Comptroller may permit the continuance of the use of the first-mentioned form up to and inclusive of 31st day of December, 1947, or until such further time as he may in any particular case permit.
