## THE COUNTIES (TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE) **REGULATIONS 1951**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 20th day of March, 1951

#### THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Counties Act, 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Counties (Travelling Allowance) Regulations 1951.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the first day of the month following the date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. The Counties Travelling Allowance Regulations 1927\* are hereby revoked.

3. The Travelling Allowance Regulations 1949; shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to County Councils and members thereof.

4. The subsistence allowance referred to in regulation 5 of the Travelling Allowance Regulations 1949<sup>†</sup> shall be at the rate of £1 15s. a dav:

Provided that where a member is entitled to a subsistence allowance and occupies a hotel room for one night only, an additional amount of 2s. may be paid to that member.

5. The mileage allowance referred to in regulation 13 of the Travelling Allowance Regulations 1949<sup>†</sup> shall be calculated in accordance with the following table except in the case of journeys performed on horseback or in a horse drawn vehicle when the mileage allowance shall be at the rate of 7d, a mile.

Horse Power of Car.	Mileage Allowanc
Not exceeding $9\frac{1}{2}$	5½d. a mile.
Exceeding $9\frac{1}{2}$ but not exceeding $14\frac{1}{2}$	6¼d. a mile.
Exceeding $14\frac{1}{2}$	7d. a mile.

6. The garage expenses referred to in regulation 13 of the Travelling Allowance Regulations 1949<sup>†</sup> shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night that the vehicle has to be kept away from home.

7. The cost of stabling referred to in regulation 13 of the Travelling Allowance Regulations 1949\* shall not exceed 5s. for every night that the horse has to be kept away from home.

8. Any County Council may, with the sanction of the Audit Office, pay to any member of the Council, instead of the payments authorized by the foregoing regulations, a sum not exceeding his actual reasonable out of pocket expenses.
