ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 8th day of December 1965

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Civil Aviation Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Civil Aviation Regulations 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 143 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3), and substituting the following subclause:

“(3) When an operation is commenced over a new route, the Director may grant exemption from the requirements of paragraphs (a), (b), and (d) of subclause (1) hereof subject to such conditions as he thinks fit in the interest of safety.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations modify the existing provisions relating to qualifications of pilots commencing operations over routes on which they have not previously flown as pilot in command in scheduled air services. At present the Director may relax these requirements only if the aircraft does not carry fare-paying passengers. The amendment revokes this restriction, and permits the Director to relax these requirements whether or not fare-paying passengers are carried, subject to such conditions as he thinks fit in the interests of safety.
