THE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS 1953, AMENDMENT NO. 21

At the Government House at Wellington this 16th day of June 1975 Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Civil Aviation Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 21, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Civil Aviation Regulations 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Examinations—Regulation 264 (1) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 21 (1) of the Civil Aviation Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 18) is hereby amended by adding to the table, under the cross-heading "Aircraft Maintenance Engineer", the following words:

"Note: 1. No fee shall be charged for the exchange of a previously issued New Zealand licence for an Aircraft Maintenance Engineer Mechanical or Avionic Licence.

"2. The fee in respect of the renewal of aircraft maintenance engineer licence ratings, shall be \$2, irrespective of the number of types or groups of aircraft or aircraft components, for which the ratings are held."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations reinstate the scale of fees payable in respect of aircraft maintenance engineer licences and ratings. The scale was mistakenly revoked owing to a drafting error.
