**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 24th day of March 1969

Present:

**HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the Counties Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Counties Accounting Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Counties Accounting Regulations 1958\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1969.

**2. Plant and Machinery Operating Account**—The Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 8 of the Counties Accounting Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by revoking form 3, and substituting the form 3 set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations substitute a new form of Plant and Machinery Operating Account. The new form requires surpluses to be transferred from that Account to the General Account or Special Fund Account, but not to any other appropriate account unless the Audit Office so directs.
