**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 9th day of October 1989

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 447 of the Children, Young Persons, and Their Families Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Children and Young Persons (Residential Care) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Children and Young Persons (Residential Care) Regulations 1986\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1989.

**2. Certain provisions relating to secure care revoked**—Regulations 28 and 31 of the principal regulations are hereby revoked.

**3. Periodic review of placement in secure care**—Regulation 32 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from subclause (1), and from subclause (2), the expression “subclauses (3) and (4)”, and substituting in each case the expression “subclause (4)”:
- (b) By revoking subclause (3).

**4. Admission Register**—Regulation 37 (2) (f) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “subclause (1) (c) or subclause (5) (d) of regulation 31 of these regulations”, and substituting the expression “section 369 of the Act”.

**5. Secure Care Register**—Regulation 41 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraphs (d) and (e), and substituting the following paragraph:

- “(d) The full name of each person who is notified under section 369 of the Act that the child or young person has been placed in secure care, and the date on which each such person is so notified.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 November 1989, amend the Children and Young Persons (Residential Care) Regulations 1986.

The regulations revoke certain provisions of the principal regulations that are inconsistent with the provisions of the Children, Young Persons, and Their Families Act 1989 relating to secure care, and make amendments consequential on that revocation.
