**THE CATTLE BRUCELLOSIS CONTROL REGULATIONS 1966,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 22nd day of September 1969

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Cattle Brucellosis Control Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Cattle Brucellosis Control Regulations 1966* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1969.

2. Interpretation—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the definition of the term “Maximum specified age”, and substituting the following definition:

“‘Maximum specified age’ means, in relation to any female calf, its age on the day 6 months after the date of its birth.”

3. Minimum age for vaccination—The principal regulations are hereby further amended by omitting the word “four” where it appears in subclause (2) of regulation 2, regulation 3, and regulation 5, and substituting in each case the expression “3”.

4. Chief Veterinary Officer—Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “Chief Inspector of Stock”, and substituting the words “Chief Veterinary Officer”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the principal regulations, with effect on and after 1 October 1969, so as to provide that the compulsory vaccination of female calves shall be done when the calves have attained the age of 3 months and are not over the age of 6 months.
