PURSUANT to section 234 (d) of the Copyright Act 1994, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Copyright (Prescribed Body) (Christian Ministries with Disabled Trust) Regulations 1995.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 12th day of June 1995.

2. Prescribed body—The Christian Ministries with Disabled Trust, a trust incorporated under the Charitable Trusts Act 1957, is hereby declared to be a prescribed body for the purposes of section 69 of the Copyright Act 1994.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 12 June 1995, declare the Christian Ministries with Disabled Trust to be a prescribed body for the purposes of section 69 of the Copyright Act 1994. Section 69 allows a prescribed body, if the statutory conditions are met, to make copies of published literary or dramatic works for the purpose of providing persons who have a print disability with copies that are in Braille or otherwise modified for their special needs, without infringing copyright in those literary or dramatic works.
