HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Marketing Act, 1936, and the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act, 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Cool-stored Butter Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Cool-stored Butter Regulations 1938\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking clause 4, and substituting the following clause:—
- "4. Every owner or occupier of a cool store shall forthwith after the 28th day of October, 1943, complete and deliver to the Department a return showing with respect to all cool-stored butter for the time being deposited in his store on the date aforesaid and held on behalf of any person other than a manufacturer of butter or the Department the following particulars:—
  - "(a) The name and address of every such person:
  - "(b) The total quantity of cool-stored butter held on behalf of each such person:
  - "(c) The respective dates on which that butter was deposited in his store, and the total quantity of butter deposited on each date:
  - "(d) The respective grades of that butter at the respective dates of deposit in his store."

3. Clause 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "by notice in writing given to such owner or occupier", the words "or by public notice".
