THE CHILD CARE CENTRE REGULATIONS 1960,
AMENDMENT NO. 3

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 6th day of June 1972

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Child Welfare Act 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Child Care Centre Regulations 1960, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Child Care Centre Regulations 1960* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 7th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Play and other equipment for use by children—Regulation 21 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2) the words “authorised to care”, and substituting the words “which cares”.

3. Safety—Regulation 22 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2), and substituting the following subclause:

“(2) It shall be the duty of the licensee and of any person responsible for the control of any child care centre and of every adult staff member to ensure that the requirements of this regulation are met and that, so far as is reasonably practicable, hazards to the safety of the children attending the centre are corrected, repaired, removed, or made inaccessible to the children.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations apply 2 provisions of the Child Care Centre Regulations 1960 to unregistered child care centres. The duty to eliminate hazards to safety is now imposed not only on the licensee of a child care centre but also on any person responsible for the control of any child care centre and on every adult staff member.
