THE CARGO CONTROL EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1947

At the Government House at Wellington, this 15th day of October, 1947

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Cargo Control Emergency Regulations 1947.
- 2. The Cargo Control Emergency Regulations 1942* and the Cargo Control Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 1†, are hereby revived and shall continue in force and apply as if they had never been revoked, subject to the modifications hereinafter appearing.
- 3. (1) The Minister of Labour may from time to time appoint for any Cargo Control Committee a Secretary and such other officers and servants as he thinks fit.
- (2) Every officer and servant appointed under this regulation shall hold office during the pleasure of the Minister of Labour and shall be entitled to receive such salary or other remuneration as may be approved by the Minister of Finance.
- (3) Nothing in the Public Service Act, 1912, shall apply with respect to any officer or servant appointed under this regulation.
- 4. While the Cargo Control Emergency Regulations 1942 continue in force pursuant to these regulations they shall be read and construed as if they had been amended as follows:—
 - (a) By revoking clause 7 thereof:
 - (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) of subclause (2) of clause 9 thereof all words after the words "specified time":

- (c) By omitting from clause 16 thereof the words "the War Expenses Account "wherever those words occur, and substituting in each place the words "the Consolidated Fund".
- 5. Any moneys payable out of the Consolidated Fund pursuant to clause 16 of the Cargo Control Emergency Regulations 1942 as modified by the last preceding regulation shall be paid out of moneys to be appropriated by Parliament for the purpose.
