

## THE COOPERATIVE COMPANIES ORDER 1962

## COBHAM, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 9th day of May 1962

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Cooperative Companies Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

## ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Cooperative Companies Order 1962.
- 2. Cooperative aerial topdressing companies are hereby declared to be cooperative companies for the purposes of the Cooperative Companies Act 1956.
- 3. In this order the term "cooperative aerial topdressing company" means a company the principal object of which is the topdressing from the air of land farmed by the shareholders of the company, and of the shares issued by which not less than three-fifths in nominal value are held by the farmers of land topdressed by the company.
