

THE COOPERATIVE COMPANIES ORDER 1965

Pursuant to the Cooperative Companies Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Cooperative Companies Order 1965.
- 2. Cooperative meat by-products marketing companies are hereby declared to be cooperative companies for the purposes of the Cooperative Companies Act 1956.
 - 3. In this order—
 - "Cooperative meat by-products marketing company" means a company the principal object of which is the treatment and marketing of meat by-products supplied to the company by its shareholders and of the shares issued by which not less than three-fifths in nominal value are held by persons engaged in supplying meat by-products to the company:
 - "Meat by-products" means hides, skins, casings, offal, wool, and manure resulting as by-products from the slaughter and dressing of stock for meat:
 - "Meat" and "stock" have the same meanings as in the Meat Act 1964.
