

THE COOPERATIVE COMPANIES ORDER 1966

PURSUANT to the Cooperative Companies Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Cooperative Companies Order 1966.
- 2. Cooperative lime companies are hereby declared to be cooperative companies for the purposes of the Cooperative Companies Act 1956.
- 3. In this order "cooperative lime company" means a company the principal object of which is the manufacture of lime for the use of its shareholders, the sale to other persons of lime manufactured by it that is surplus to the requirements of its shareholders, and the carrying on of other activities incidental thereto.
