PURSUANT to section 70 of the Statutes Amendment Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Compensation Court Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Compensation Court Regulations 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 3A of the principal regulations (as inserted by the Compensation Court Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by revoking the proviso to subclause (1).
