PURSUANT to section 70 of the Statutes Amendment Act 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Compensation Court Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Compensation Court Regulations 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 3A of the principal regulations (as substituted by the Compensation Court Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 5) is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:—

“(1) There shall be paid to the Judge of the Court out of the Consolidated Fund a salary at the rate of two thousand pounds a year, together with such travelling allowances as may be fixed from time to time by the Governor-General.”
