THE COMMUNICABLE DISEASES NOTICE 1951

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Communicable Diseases Notice 1951.

2. Tuberculous disease, in any form, is hereby declared to be a communicable disease within the meaning of the Health Act 1920.
