



THE CUSTOMS DUTY ON GOVERNMENT GOODS ORDER 1986

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 25th day of August 1986

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 166 (1) of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Duty on Government Goods Order 1986.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1986.

2. Duty on Government goods—It is hereby determined that duty in accordance with the Customs Act 1966 shall be levied, collected, and paid on all goods being the property of the Crown in respect of the Government of New Zealand, which are—

- (a) Imported into New Zealand and entered for home consumption; or
- (b) Entered for export and exported out of New Zealand.

3. Revocations—The following orders are hereby revoked:

- (a) The Customs Duty on Government Goods Order 1944*:
- (b) The Customs Duty on Government Goods Order 1965†:
- (c) The Customs Duty on Government Goods Order 1982‡.

This order makes all Crown imports liable to Customs duty in the same manner as other imports.
