THE CUSTOMS DUTIES SUSPENSION ORDER 1951

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 7th day of
November 1951

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Customs Amendment Act 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the existing duties are likely to operate in an injurious manner generally to the public interest, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Duties Suspension Order 1951.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 9th day of November 1951.
2. This order applies to all duties of Customs, including surtax and primage duty, and whether imposed by—
 - (a) The existing Tariff (being the First Schedule to the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1934); or
 - (b) Part I or Part II of Schedule XIII to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, as set out in the First Schedule to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade Act 1948, as amended by the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade Order 1950*; or
 - (c) The Second Schedule to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade Act 1948, as amended by the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade Order 1950*; or
 - (d) Schedule B to the Trade Agreement between Canada and New Zealand, as set out in the Appendix to the Trade Agreement (New Zealand and Canada) Ratification Act 1932, as amended by the Trade Agreement (Canada) Order 1938†; or
 - (e) Any other enactment.
3. All duties relating to the goods set out in the First Schedule hereto are hereby suspended until the 30th day of June 1952.
4. All duties relating to the goods set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby suspended until the 31st day of December 1952.
5. Every suspension of duty hereby effected shall be subject to the provisions of section 143 of the Customs Act 1913.

6. All duties of Customs that have become due and payable and all penalties and forfeitures that have been incurred before the commencement of this order shall be recovered and enforced as if this order had not been made.

SCHEDULES

FIRST SCHEDULE

GOODS ON WHICH DUTIES SUSPENDED UNTIL 30 JUNE 1952

Tariff Item No.	Goods.
357	Metal, viz. :— (4) Iron, galvanized or <i>plain</i> black, viz., angle, tee, bar, bolt, channel, rod, and rolled girders; iron girders expanded, but otherwise unworked. (5) Iron, viz. :— (a) Sheet, plate (including rolled chequered plates), or hoop (except hoop 6 inches in width or over), <i>plain</i> , whether black, polished, galvanized, plated, tinned, or otherwise coated with metal, n.e.i. (b) Corrugated sheet iron. Ex (10) Wire, metal, plain, n.e.i.; wire cut to lengths, looped, twisted, or plain, suited for baling and similar purposes.
362	Pipes, piping, tubes, and tubing (except coil pipes), viz. :— (3) Wrought iron, or steel, screwed; boiler tubes flanged or unflanged; and all pipes, piping, tubes, and tubing, n.e.i.
376	Ex (1) Wire netting.

SECOND SCHEDULE

GOODS ON WHICH DUTIES SUSPENDED UNTIL 31 DECEMBER 1952

Tariff Item No.	Goods.
357	Ex (6) Corrugated aluminium sheet.
404	Timber, rough sawn or <i>rough hewn</i> , viz. :— Ex (2) Redwood, Douglas fir and other coniferous, in pieces having a length of not less than 25 feet, and having a minimum cross sectional area of not less than 150 square inches. Ex (3) N.e.i., viz. : Douglas fir and other coniferous.

This order suspends all Customs duties (including surtax and primage duty) on certain goods until 30 June 1952 and on certain other goods until 31 December 1952.
