ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 13th day of November 1972

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 124 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the existing duties are likely to operate in an injurious manner generally to the public interest, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Timber) Suspension Order 1972.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1973.

2. Tariff amended—All rates of duty imposed on the goods set out in the Schedule hereto, being rates of duty specified in the Customs Tariff, are hereby suspended until the end of December 1973.

3. Consequential revocations—The Customs Duties (Timber) Suspension Order 1970* and the Customs Duties (Timber) Suspension Order 1971⁺ are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order suspends, until the end of December 1973, all duties of Customs on rough-sawn redwood and western red cedar timbers, and on rough-sawn Douglas fir (Oregon pine) "clears" timber.
