PURSUANT to section 124 of the Customs Act 1966 and section 11 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the existing duties are likely to operate in an injurious manner generally to the public interest, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Timber) Suspension Order 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1974.

2. Tariff amended—All rates of duty imposed on the goods set out in the Schedule hereto, being rates of duty specified in the Customs Tariff, are hereby suspended until the end of December 1974.

3. Consequential revocation—The Customs Duties (Timber) Suspension Order 1973* is hereby revoked.
