THE CRANES EXEMPTION ORDER 1966

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Cranes Exemption Order 1966.
2. Cranes of the class referred to in the Schedule hereto shall not be subject to the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes Act 1950.

SCHEDULE

ANY lifting appliance (including all equipment used in the operation of the appliance) consisting of a jib fixed to a tractor while used by a farmer, or a person under his direction, on a farm occupied by the farmer.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order exempts certain lifting appliances used on farms for handling farm produce, from the provisions of the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes Act 1950.
