



THE CUSTOMS EXAMINING PLACE FEES REGULATIONS 1985

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of October 1985

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 32 (8) of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs Examining Place Fees Regulations 1985.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1985.

2. Fee for examining place—(1) Subject to subclause (2) of this regulation, the controlling authority of any place appointed pursuant to section 32 of the Customs Act 1966 as a place for the examination of goods subject to the control of the Customs, shall pay to the Collector the appropriate fee prescribed in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Nothing in this regulation shall apply to—

(a) Any examining place situated within any area declared by the Comptroller pursuant to section 28 of the Customs Act 1966 to be a wharf; or

- (b) Any examining place situated within any area declared by the Comptroller pursuant to section 30 of the Customs Act 1966 to be a customs airport; or
- (c) Any place appointed pursuant to section 32 of the Customs Act 1966 as an examination place for servicemans' personal effects.
