PURSUANT to section 32 (8) of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs Examining Place Fees Regulations 1985, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Examining Place Fees Regulations 1985* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1986.

2. Schedule—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the new Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
