THE CUSTOMS EXPORT PROHIBITION ORDER, 1937, NO. 1.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Date of enactment: 9th day of April, 1937.

Date of notification in Gazette: 15th day of April, 1937.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by section 47 of the Customs Act, 1913, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and being of opinion that the prohibition hereinafter enacted is necessary in the public interest, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Export Prohibition Order, 1937, No. 1.

2. The exportation is prohibited, save with the consent of the Minister of Customs, of phormium-tenax plants and seeds.

3. This Order in Council shall come into force on the day following notification of the making thereof in the *Gazette*.
