THE CUSTOMS EXPORT PROHIBITION ORDER (NO. 2) 1950

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 47 of the Customs Act, 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being of opinion that the prohibition hereinafter enacted is necessary in the public interest, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Customs Export Prohibition Order (No. 2) 1950.
- (2) This Order shall come into force on the day following the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. The exportation of semen of Merino sheep is hereby prohibited, save with the consent of the Minister of Customs and subject to such conditions as he thinks fit to impose.
