PURSUANT to section 70 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Export Prohibition Order (No. 2) 1973.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Exportation of animal fodder and cereal grains prohibited—The exportation of the goods specified in the Schedule to this order is hereby prohibited, except with the consent of the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries and subject to such conditions as he thinks fit to impose.

### **SCHEDULE**

Animal fodder of all kinds. Cereal grains of all kinds.
