THE CHILLED EGGS (MARKETING) REGULATIONS 1935, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

GALWAY, Governor-General.
ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 27th day of July, 1938.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Poultry Act, 1924, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Chilled Eggs (Marketing) Regulations 1935, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Chilled Eggs (Marketing) Regulations 1935* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of

August, 1938.

4. The principal regulations are amended by inserting next after

clause 12 thereof the following additional clauses:—

"12A. No person shall deliver or cause to be delivered to any approved cool store, and no person being the owner or occupier of an approved cool store shall accept delivery at his cool store of any eggs for the purpose of being chilled unless such eggs are packed in a package or container of the type prescribed by clause 12B hereof.

"12B. All eggs intended for deposit in an approved cool store shall be packed in a clean and odourless package or container fitted with standard fillers and standard flats, or standard filler-flats, all of which

fittings shall be clean and odourless."

5. Clause 15 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting next after the word "package" wherever that word occurs in the said clause the words "or container".

6. Clause 18 of the principal regulations is revoked.

7. Clause 19 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words "Subject to the provisions of the last preceding clause hereof".
