THE COUNTY ENROLMENT REGULATIONS 1953, AMENDMENT NO. 5

Pursuant to the Counties Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the County Enrolment Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the County Enrolment Regulations 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Fee for copies of riding rolls—Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (3) all words after the words "not exceeding", and substituting the words "30c for the roll of any 1 riding (including all its supplements) nor \$1 for the rolls of any 4 or more ridings (including all their supplements)".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the maximum fees that may be charged by County Councils for copies of riding rolls from 10c to 30c for the roll of any 1 riding (with all its supplements) and from 50c for the rolls (including supplements) of 5 or more ridings to \$1 for the rolls (including supplements) of 4 or more ridings.
