THE CORONERS' FEES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS, 1937.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.
Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : Section 2 of the
Coroners Amendment Act, 1920.

Date on which the regulations were made : 6th day of January, 1937.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 8th day of January, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Coroners' Fees Amendment Regulations, 1937.

2. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.

3. The regulations, made under section 2 of the Coroners Amendment Act, 1920, on the 19th day of October, 1931,* are hereby amended by revoking the proviso therein following the words "For every inquest £1 0s. 0d."

4. The said regulations are further amended by inserting after the item "For making a post-mortem examination, &c., £3 3s. 0d." the following additional words :—

"Provided that the Minister of Justice may allow a larger fee than any of the foregoing in any case where he considers that exceptional circumstances render such a course desirable."
