THE CONTROLLED FISHERIES EXTENSION ORDER 1978

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 148 of the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Controlled Fisheries Extension Order 1978.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1978.

2. Scallop fisheries that may be declared to be controlled fisheries extended—The Second Schedule to the Fisheries Act 1908 (as added by section 3 of the Fisheries Amendment Act 1977) is hereby amended by inserting, in the column headed “Area in which controlled fishery may be declared” in relation to scallops, the following paragraph:

“(c) Scallop fisheries within New Zealand fisheries waters on the East Coast of the North Island between Cape Brett and North Cape.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order includes the scallop fisheries in the North Island between Cape Brett and North Cape within those fisheries that may be declared to be controlled fisheries.
