THE CONTROLLED FISHERIES (SOUTHERN ROCK LOBSTER FISHERY) NOTICE 1980, AMENDMENT NO. 3

PURSUANT to section 118 of the Fisheries Act 1908, the Minister of Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Controlled Fisheries (Southern Rock Lobster Fishery) Notice 1980, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Controlled Fisheries (Southern Rock Lobster Fishery) Notice 1980* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Maximum number of licences—(1) Clause 3 of the principal notice is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2) (as added by clause 2 of the Controlled Fisheries (Southern Rock Lobster Fishery) Notice 1980, Amendment No. 1 and amended by clause 2 of the Controlled Fisheries (Southern Rock Lobster Fishery) Notice 1980, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the following subclause:

"(2) The maximum number of licences that may be granted by the Fisheries Licensing Authority in respect of the Southern rock lobster fishery is hereby fixed at 230."

(2) The Controlled Fisheries (Southern Rock Lobster Fishery) Notice 1980, Amendment No. 1 and the Controlled Fisheries (Southern Rock Lobster Fishery) Notice 1980, Amendment No. 2 are hereby consequentially revoked.
