

THE CONTROLLED FISHERIES (TARANAKI ROCK LOBSTER FISHERY) NOTICE 1981

Pursuant to section 118 of the Fisheries Act 1908, the Minister of Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Controlled Fisheries (Taranaki Rock Lobster Fishery) Notice 1981.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 16th day of March 1981.

2. Interpretation—(1) In this notice,—

"Manawatu River entrance" means that point on the southern bank

of the Manawatu River at 40°28′4″S and 175°12′5″E:

"Taranaki rock lobster fishery" means the rock lobster fishery within New Zealand fisheries waters, as defined on Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries Map No. 151 (File reference 20/1/5) held in the Head Office of the said Ministry, bounded—

(a) By the shoreline (commencing in a southerly direction) from the North Head of Kaipara Harbour (36°24'S and 174°03.5'E)

to the Manawatu River entrance:

(b) By a straight line from the Manawatu River entrance to Bushend Point light:

(c) By a straight line from Bush-end Point light on a true compass bearing of 317°:

- (d) By a straight line from Kaipara Harbour North Head on a true compass bearing of 270°:
- (2) Words and expressions in this notice which are defined in Part I or Part III of the Fisheries Act 1908 have the meanings so defined.
- 3. Declaration of controlled fishery—The Taranaki rock lobster fishery is hereby declared to be a controlled fishery for the purposes of Part III of the Fisheries Act 1908.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice declares the Taranaki rock lobster fishery to be a controlled

fishery on and from 16 March 1981.

A special licence from the Fisheries Licensing Authority is required to fish in a controlled fishery.
