



**THE CONTROLLED FISHERIES (SOUTHERN SCALLOP  
FISHERY) NOTICE 1978**

PURSUANT to section 118 of the Fisheries Act 1908, the Minister of Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

**NOTICE**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Controlled Fisheries (Southern Scallop Fishery) Notice 1978.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1978.

**2. Interpretation**—(1) In this notice, "Southern scallop fishery" means the scallop fisheries within New Zealand fisheries waters between Cape Campbell and Kahurangi Point.

(2) Words and expressions in this notice which are defined in the Fisheries Act 1908 have the meanings so defined.

**3. Declaration of controlled fishery**—The Southern scallop fishery is hereby declared to be a controlled fishery for the purposes of Part III of the Fisheries Act 1908.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice declares the Southern scallop fishery to be a controlled fishery on and from 1 June 1978. A special licence from the Fisheries Licensing Authority is required to fish in a controlled fishery.
