THE CANADIAN GOOSE PROTECTION ORDER 1939.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921–22, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This order may be cited as the Canadian Goose Protection Order 1939.

2. From and after the date hereof the Canadian goose (*Branta canadensis*) shall be deemed to be included in the Second Schedule of the said Act.
