**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 4th day of August 1986

Present:

**HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 53 of the Commerce Act 1986 and section 123A of the Social Security Act 1964 (as inserted by section 110 (1) of the Commerce Act 1986), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Minister of Health, who is satisfied that—

- (a) The goods described in the Schedule to this order will be supplied in a market in which competition is limited; and
- (b) It is desirable for the prices of the goods described in the Schedule to this order to be controlled in accordance with the Commerce Act 1986 in the interests of both users and consumers,—

hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Controlled Goods (Drug Tariff) Order (No. 2) 1986.

**2. Commencement and expiry**—(1) This order shall come into force on the 5th day of August 1986.

(2) This order shall continue in force until the close of the 1st day of December 1986, and shall then expire.

**3. Continuation of price control**—The prices for the goods described in the Schedule to this order shall be controlled in accordance with the Commerce Act 1986.

**4. Revocation**—The Controlled Goods (Drug Tariff) Order 1986\* is hereby revoked.

#### CONTROLLED GOODS

Drugs and any other substances and mixtures of substances specially prepared for use in the treatment, prevention, investigation, or alleviation of any disease, illness, or injury and included, on the making of this order, in the Drug Tariff 1984† (as amended by the Drug Tariff 1984, Amendment No. 7‡).

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 5 August 1986, provides that, until the close of 1 December 1986, certain drugs, substances, and mixtures of substances are to be under price control. They are drugs and any other substances and mixtures of substances specially prepared for use in the treatment, prevention, investigation, or alleviation of any disease, illness, or injury and included, on the making of this order, in the Drug Tariff 1984 (as amended by the Drug Tariff 1984, Amendment No. 7).

The Controlled Goods (Drug Tariff) Order 1986, which is revoked by this order, applied to certain drugs, substances, and mixtures of substances included in the Drug Tariff 1984 (as amended by the Drug Tariff 1984, Amendment No. 6).

This order accordingly takes account of the amendments made to the Drug Tariff 1984 by the Drug Tariff 1984, Amendment No. 7. That amendment deleted some items and added others.
